# Hillman chamber shows off traveling buck pole

HILLMAN — More than 200 people stopped to check out the new traveling buck pole the Hillman Area Chamber of Commerce invested in this year.

The project has been in the works for several months now, as the old buck pole became unsafe for use.

Inspired by one of his own buck poles, chamber of commerce President James Paczkowski helped to create the design which he said has been warmly received by passers-by.

"We're really happy with this," he said. "We've had a lot of traffic stopping to get pictures and see the nice bucks."

Paczkowski estimated more than 200 people stopped to check out the deer and buck pole throughout the day. However, he said it could have been significantly higher with many vehicles stopping to take a picture but not getting out.

Hanging from the buck pole were 14 bucks, the largest of which were two 10pointers.

The deer could come from anywhere within a 25 mile radius and hunters then were entered into several contests from the buck's weight, spread and number of horns.

The new buck pole was paid for with donations from local businesses that also included the labor on some of the add-ons to the trailer. This included two LED lights mounted to the top for night time viewing as well as a swing-arm scale to weigh the incoming deer.

In total the buck pole cost close to \$5,000 and took nearly 10 weeks to complete. It is capable of holding 20 deer at one time.

Any local business that has the room and wants to host the buck pole can do so because of the versatility of the unit, Paczkowski said.

Visitors to the buck pole also could take their pick of baked goods from Hillman Community Schools while visiting.

While being there starting at 6:30 a.m. on Tuesday, the first deer did not come in until around 9:30 a.m. Then it was not until 12:30 p.m. when several deer began being brought in.

Paczkowski said he always enjoys seeing someone bring in a buck because he gets to hear their stories.

"The fun part is listening to

their stories," he said. "Everybody has a story of how they get the deer."

The buck pole was open through Wednesday allowing for even more bucks to come in. The winners would be decided at the end of the two days.
