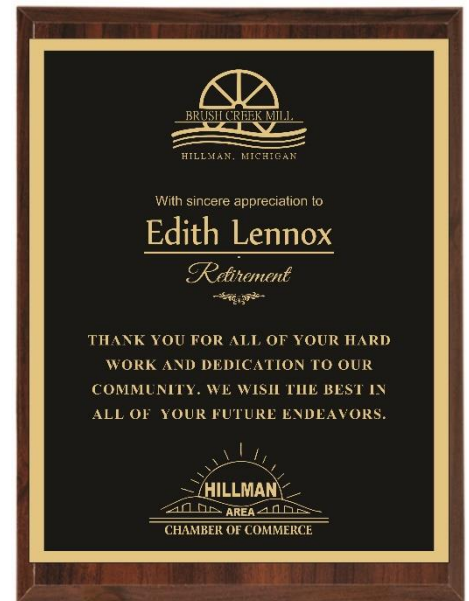
Membership Dues

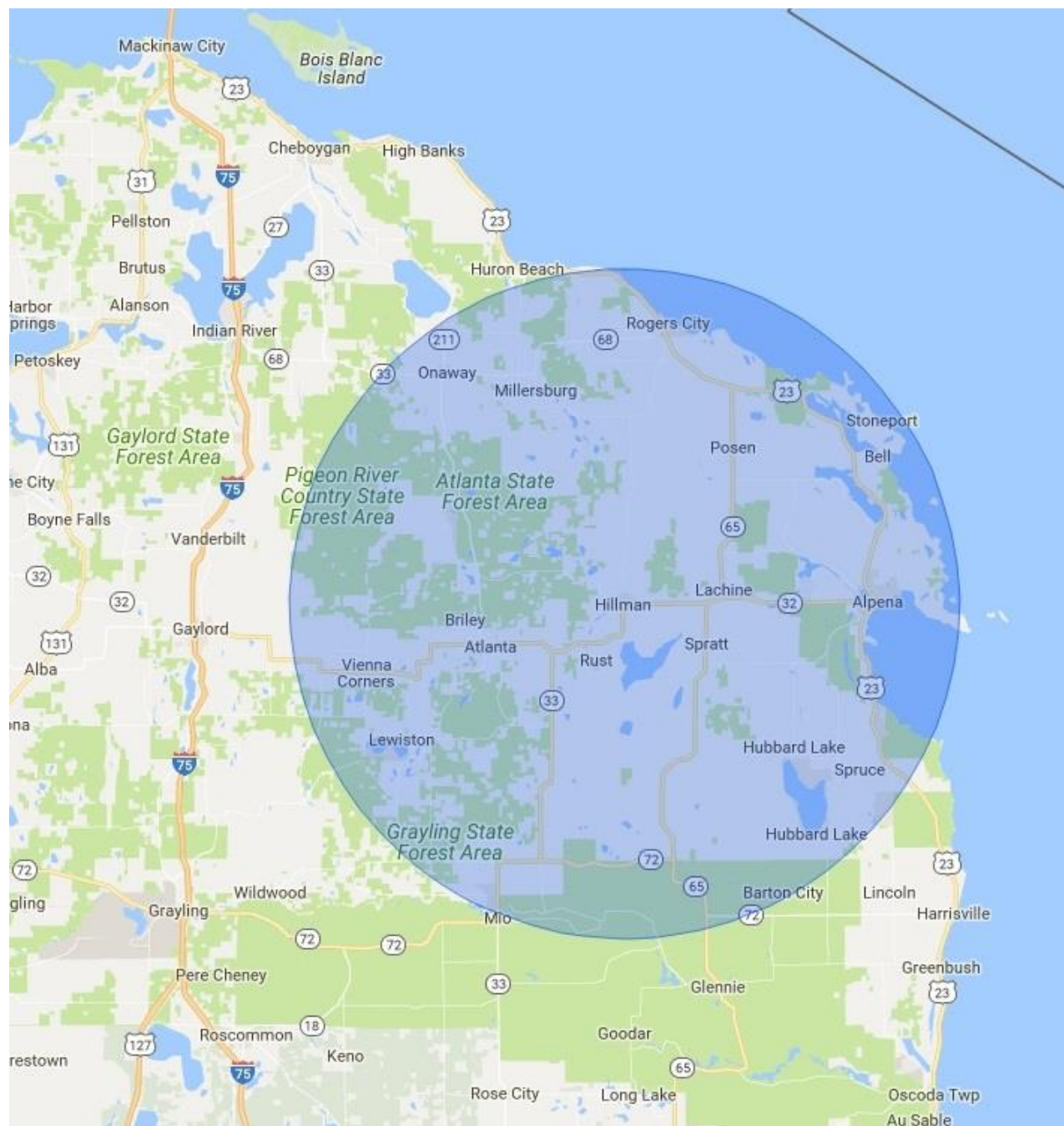

----- RULES & MAP ON BACK -----

RULES TO ENTER

- Buck must be shot in Hillman Area within 30 miles
- Buck must have hind legs split (heart and lungs removed)
- Hunter must have identification that matches tag number, in order to remove deer
- To qualify deer must hang until 9 p.m “weather permitting”
- RACK-Points must be 1”. SPREAD – Will be measured on the widest inside point of main beam (BODY MUST BE ATTACHED, IN OTHER WORDS WHOLE)
- One prize per hunter
- Prizes will be awarded after 9 p.m. on the 15th
