





- Hunter must have identification that matches tag number, in order to remove deer
- . To qualify deer must hang until 8 p.m Friday or Saturday "weather permitting"
- RACK-Points must be 1". SPREAD Will be measured on the widest inside point of main beam (BODY MUST BE ATTACHED, IN OTHER WORDS WHOLE)
- · One prize per hunter
